### IMPORTANT FACTS

#### PARENTAL CONSENT & INSURANCE

A parental consent form and insurance form will be sent once the application has been received or may be printed from our Web site at [www.mtsusocccamps.com](http://www.mtsusocccamps.com). No camper is allowed to compete unless a fully completed health form is on file. Athletic trainers are on duty at all times to administer to minor injuries and sickness. Personal insurance will be used as the primary coverage.

#### COMMUTERS

Commuter fees include instruction, lunch, and dinner. Commuter campers must check in on the first day at the same time and location as resident campers. On the following days commuter sessions run from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m.

#### FACILITIES AND ACCOMODATIONS

Residential campers will be housed two (2) per room in the MTSU dormitories. Dorms are located within a short walk of the fully lighted grass playing fields, campus cafeterias, and the Keathley University Center for entertainment during the limited free time the camper has. As your child's safety is our priority, campers are under constant supervision of counselors and dormitory personnel. Roommate preferences will be honored whenever possible, but are not guaranteed and requests must be made in advance. We must have both applications on file and both deposits before space can be reserved. If a coach assigns roommates, then those assignments will have priority over individual requests.

## CAMP DESCRIPTION

### GIRLS' HIGH SCHOOL TEAM CAMP

The Girls' High School Team Camp is an intense week of training. Unlike other team camps, the Middle Tennessee team camp is a customized training program for each participating team. Each team will be assigned to a staff member who will ensure the team's development throughout the week. Teams get multiple matches each day, both full-field and small-sided, allowing players to improve their skills under pressure. Coaches will observe their teams during matches and have daily meetings with the staff coach to discuss team needs. All matches will be played on site at the MTSU Soccer Field. This camp is a must for any girls' high school team getting ready for the upcoming fall season! Each head coach and one (1) assistant or chaperone will receive free room and board.

- Mail the balance of your payment no later than two (2) weeks prior to the start of camp. Please put the camper's name on the check.

### CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT

Registration location and directions to the dorms and fields will be sent prior to the start of camp. Check-in will be held from 3-5 p.m. on July 23. Commuters will check out at the field after the closing ceremonies while residents will check out at the dorms. The closing ceremonies will be at 11 a.m. at the main field.

### COMMUTERS

For those not wishing to spend the night at our residential camps, we offer the chance to commute for the training sessions. All commuters should be dropped at the main field at 8:00 a.m. and can be picked up at the main dorm complex after the evening camp meeting. Commuters will eat lunch and dinner with the rest of the camp.

### CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

The deposit of \$150 is subtracted from the total fee, but is **NON-REFUNDABLE**. No refunds will be issued upon expulsion or voluntary withdrawal from camp once it has begun. Also, no refunds will be given if you cancel your reservation and fail to notify us in writing at least two (2) weeks prior to the start of camp.

### KEY DEPOSIT

A key deposit of \$60 will be collected at check-in. It will be refunded at check-out. **BRING CASH** for this deposit.
